

業者の皆様、

この度佐世保米海軍基地、極東施設支援部隊佐世保契約事務所におきまして、一般廃棄物、産業廃棄物及び医療廃棄物の回収、処理の新規契約の為に市場調査を実施したくご連絡をさせていただきました。

こちらの趣旨としましては、JEGS (Japan Environmental Governing Standards/ 日本環境管理基準)及び佐世保市、西海市の環境基準に基づき使用書上決められた箇所へ投棄された一般廃棄物、産業廃棄物、医療廃棄物、資源ごみ等の（分別を含む）回収と処理の年間契約、合計で5年間で計画しております。この契約形式としましては定期/通常作業（Recurring Work）と臨時作業（Non-Recurring Work）の2種類の形式があります。

臨時作業には通常の回収作業には含まれない臨時の廃棄物の回収処理作業が別途オーダーとして出されます。

この契約は、すべての佐世保米海軍基地施設、メインベース、軍属の住宅地（針尾住宅地を含む）SSK Dry Dock No.2、赤崎、庵崎、横瀬の貯油基地、前畑、針尾弾薬庫での作業になります。

契約業者の選定方法としましては、入札金額の他に、参加業者の皆様により下記の4つの項目に対する提出書類を入札時に提出していただきます。

1. Past Performance：過去の実績に対する顧客の評価
2. Safety：作業安全計画の審査、及び過去の安全管理の審査
3. Technical Approach (Licenses, Staffing, Vehicles and Equipment)：テクニカルアプローチ（許可証、免許、職員数、必要車両及び備品等のリストの提出）
4. Key Personnel (Project Manager, Quality Control Manager and Site Safety and Health Officer) experience information.：主要職員等（プロジェクトマネージャー、品質管理マネージャー、現場安全衛生担当責任者）の経歴

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ちなみに正式な仕様書、契約要項書等は順調に行くと8月か9月にAsiaNecoに掲載する予定です。

We are seeking seeking refuse and recycling removal and disposal include segregation basis of Japan Environmental Governing Standards (JEGS) and local (Sasebo City and Saikai City) procedures. This work will include Solid Waste, Industrial Waste and Medical Waste, as well as typical household and office wates. The work shall be performed at various locations and could vary from location to location. Work locations include Main Base (CFAS Sasebo), Main Base Housing, Dry Dock No.2, Akasaki POL Depot, Iorizaki POL Depot, Yokose POL Depot, Hario Housing, Hahio-Shima Ordnance, and Maebata Ordnance. All areas are located in Nagasaki Prefecture, Japan.

The Government has planning to acquire in a multiple year single award Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) type performance based service contract comprised of Recurring Work and Non-recurring Work Items.

The solicitation will utilize source selection procedures which require offerors to submit price proposal and technical proposal for evaluation by the Government. The non-price factors for technical proposal are;

1. Past performance
2. Safety
3. Technical Approach (Licenses, Stuffing, Vehicles and Equipment)
4. Key Personnel (Project Manager, Quality Control Manager and Site Safety and Health Officer) experience information

And a price proposal is evaluate by the Government.

The complete solicitation is planned to be announced via AsiaNECO at <https://asia.neco.navy.mil/> on/or about sometime in August or September, 2016.
